42nd Congress of the CIPS

The 42nd Congress of the International Sport Fishing Confederation – CIPS – took place in Comano Terme, Italy, in the province of Trento.



Delegates from the 156 national federations from 81 countries discussed and approved the reports of the members of the Presidium and the CIPS Standing Committees and given that it was an elective Congress (which takes place every fourth year) the delegates elected the new Presidium.

Since the outgoing President of CIPS, Mr Ferenc Szalay (Hungary) did not stand for a new term, the Congress elected a new President: Mr Ugo Claudio Matteoli (Italy), President of the Italian Federation and of the FIPSed.

The Congress unanimously voted Mr. Ferenc Szalay as Honorary President of the CIPS.

The CIPS Congress also includes the Assemblies of the International Federations, the FIPS – elective too, as every four years. The following were elected: FIPSed President Mr. Ugo Claudio Matteoli; that of FIPS-Mer Mr Gilbert Zangerlé (Luxembourg); and that of FIPS-Mouche Mr. Mario Podmanik (Slovakia).

The next Congress will take place in Mexico, in Acapulco, in the month of May 2022, the Congress in 2023 remaining looking for a national federation to organize it.
