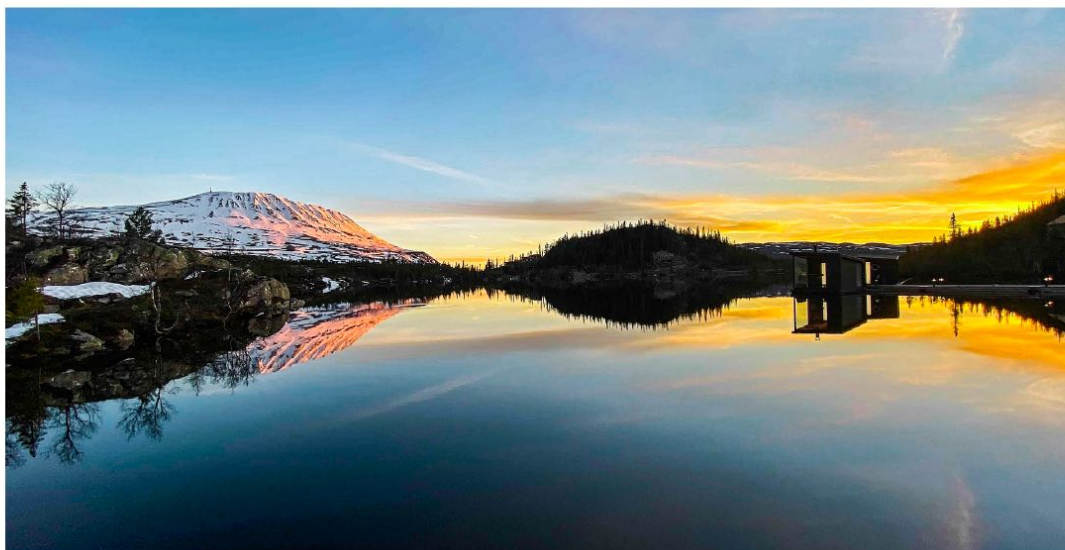

Welcome to Gaustablikk

The Tinn municipality around Gausta has approximately 800 different fishing lakes - in the summer of 2022 we welcome all our friends of casting-sport to take part in the 6th World Championship in Flycasting!

Organizer: International Casting Sport Federation ICSF

Coordinator: Norwegian Casting Federation (NCF)

Date: 10th-14th of August 2022

Sportsfield: Kvitåvatn, Gaustablikk

Participation: as set by the ICSF competition rules for Flycasting

All national organizations under ICSF/CIPS may take part in the World Championship. Each nation can participate with maximum 8 casters in each event. Arranging an event requires minimum 10 participants in total, from minimum 3 nations (per class).

Classes: Four classes divided by gender: a) men, b) women, c) veteran men and d) veteran women

Competition events: Trout accuracy, Trout distance, Seatrout distance, Salmon distance, spey distance 15,1' and spey distance 16/18'

Accommodation: Gaustablikk høyfjellshotell - <https://www.gaustablikk.no>

All accommodation in walking distance from the courts. All meals at hotel or close to the casting-court by food-trucks.

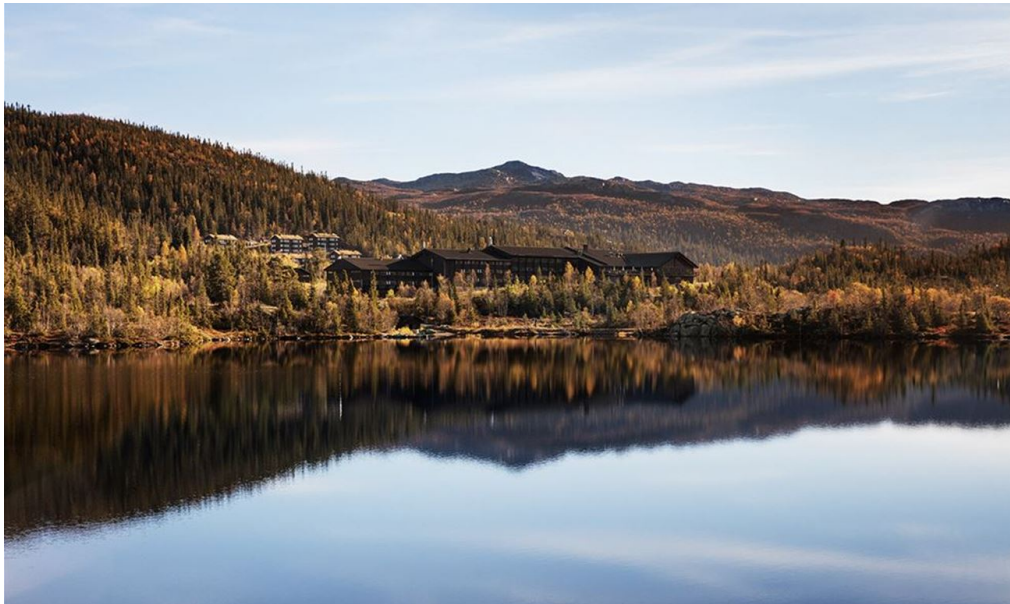

Costs: TBA – varied as the participants can choose hotel, cabin or apartments for their stay. Variation of hotels, cabins and apartments – packages. Use cost-standards set by previous championships.

Airport: Oslo Airport (Gardermoen)

Local transport: Transfer from airport to Gaustablikk (3 hr. drive) organized by NCF.



The banquet and medal ceremonies: will be organized on the top of Norway – at the mountain Gaustatoppen (1883 m. asl) - the view is impressive, as one can see an area of approximately 60,000 km², one sixth of Norway's mainland. All participants will be carried carefully by the Gaustabanen train inside the mountain to reach the peak of Gaustatoppen.

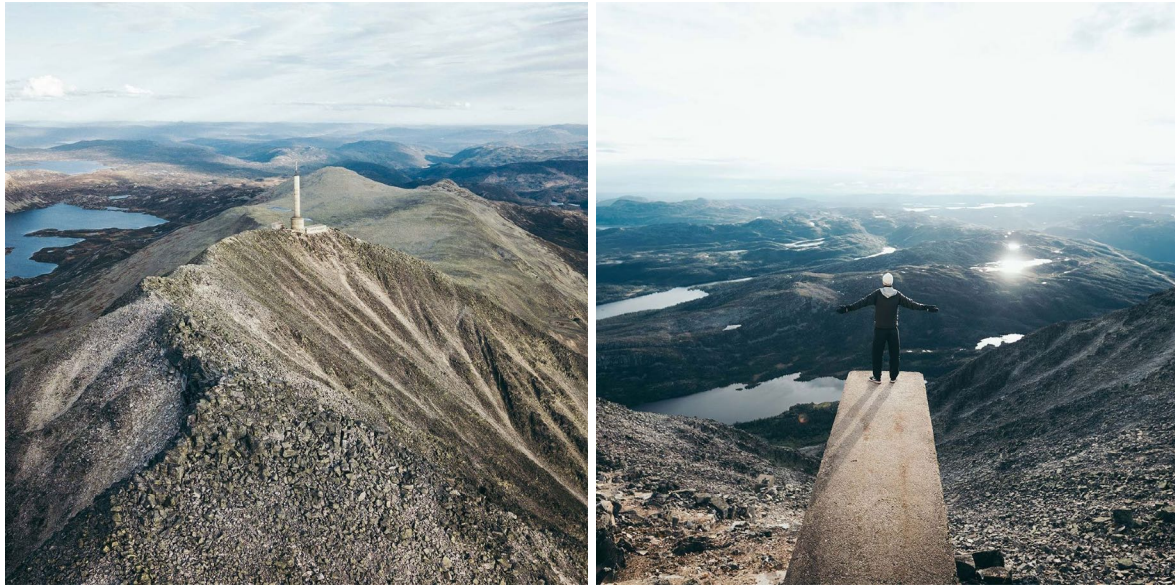
