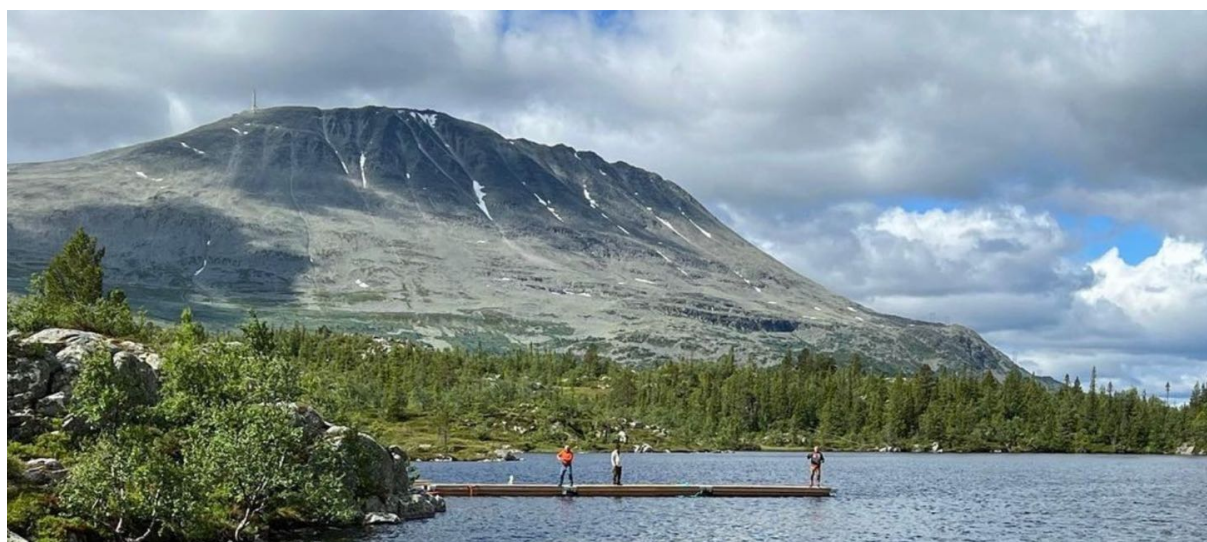

A few words on routines at Gaustablikk

A detailed program is attached for your convenience. Be aware that there may be changes should conditions change as we progress over the next days. Also, most of you will arrive Gaustablikk 9th or 10th of August, where you will check in to get your pre- ordered room. In the lobby we have established a service desk to support any inquiries you may have related to the world championship. Gausta is not a big area, and all courts are within walking distance from the hotel. As a major holiday resort, the area also has hiking opportunities right on your doorstep should that be of interest.

Breakfast is served in the hotel restaurant, while lunch and dinner buffets are available in "The athletes area". "The Athletes area" is also the location we will use for the opening ceremony Thursday and the banquet on Saturday. "The Athletes Area" is also the venue for the daily medal ceremony.

Veterinarian regulations require disinfection of fishing equipment, in particular coming from abroad. A disinfection station is therefore established to wash waders and rod/ reel. We kindly ask all to comply and disinfection before equipment is brought to the courts. More information will follow.

There will be pressure on training opportunities on the various courts. As a general rule, courts are open for practice while not in use for competitions. Courts with limited accessibility, e.g., the spey court and trout accuracy will be open 10 minutes for each caster. A management system will be established in order for all to get access. You will register directly at the court, where you are issued a timeslot for your practice. As all spey events are conducted on the same court, the court itself will be arranged from 16'/18' to 15' once a day. More information will be provided.

Courts are closed 30 minutes before competition starts. The court will not be available for practicing between qualification and final rounds.

A service area will be established, amongst other with a small kiosk and a portable WC for your convenience. The kiosk will have snacks and soft drinks for sale. We will also provide screens to present current status in this area. Real- time results will be available online via a link that we will provide.

A medal ceremony will be conducted every evening to cover the daily competitions. On Saturday, the ceremony will be conducted at the banquet.

All competitors are subject to anti- doping testing as ICSF is signatory to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC). Anti Doping Norway (ADNO) will perform tests during the competition. More information on antidoping can be found [here](#). Complying with the rules are the responsibility of each individual caster.

As casting is an outdoor sport we may encounter difficult and unexpected challenges. In particular weather may have implications. The staff will monitor amongst other the weather forecast closely. We may therefore change timings on relative short notice in order to make the best conditions fit each individual class. Conditions will not be equal for all - we know that from experience. But striving for as much equality as we can is what we can offer.

As a practical note - cash is not widely used in Norway. You can pay almost everything everywhere with any of the major credit cards. That is often preferred over cash.

On organization

The organization is not huge, but we believe it is sufficient to kick off and manage the event. A secretariat is established to centrally manage two groups of judges for parallel competitions. Terje Slydahl manages the secretariat, and Ronny Stavsholt manages all the judges. There is a pool of local volunteers who will support all kinds of tasks, from note- takers and kiosk managers, to service desk manning and support during the banquet. During the competition, these are managed by Roger Fjellstad.

A jury is required, and is formed as competitors and visitors arrive Gausta. Any of you feeling the need to contribute are welcome to volunteer for jury work. Contact the secretariat to map interest.

We have scheduled administrative meetings every day throughout the competition. This meeting schedule is kicked off Wednesday afternoon in order to prepare the Jury, Judges/ court staff, and the Team Captains. The latter is particularly important as we need to establish a system in which e.g., training opportunities and general expectations are met as early and clear as possible. More information will be provided as we get closer to the event on who is expected to be in which meeting.

Press will be managed by the secretariat. If you have special national caveats or requests then let the secretariat know as soon as possible.
