The first mention of this sport in our country dates back to 1935, when the first competitions in this fishing discipline were held in Jindřichův Hradec. Today, we can be proud of that it is the most successful fishing sport at the domestic, European and world level. Finals: Participant per discipline becomes carried out a final with the women with 6 women only as of 9. Participant per discipline becomes carried out a final with the men with 8 men only as of 12.

All finals in the event 1-4, 6 and are to be cast at the same time and the same conditions. The finals for the plug distance events 5, 7 will take place at one court chosen by the International Chief Judge. If there are not 6 courts we will cast the finals in 2 rounds, half in each round.

The casting courts will be taken by the caster in the reverse order of the achieved results in the qualification round, like f. ex. men division: court 1 – caster place 6, court 2 – caster place 5. If there are more casters than courts in any event, the available courts are drawn out to groups with the same number of casters beginning in the reverse order of the achieved results in the qualification round, f. ex.: 6-4 and 3-1.

Teams: Teams men consists of respectively 4 Junior.

Teams girls consists of respectively 2 Girls.

Team competition take place in Pentathlon (Event 1-5)

No team score it must be notified of to at least 4 's teams or 4 Junior's teams, otherwise is carried out.

Names of team members to be finally given at least 24 hours before the start in written form, to the tournament committee.

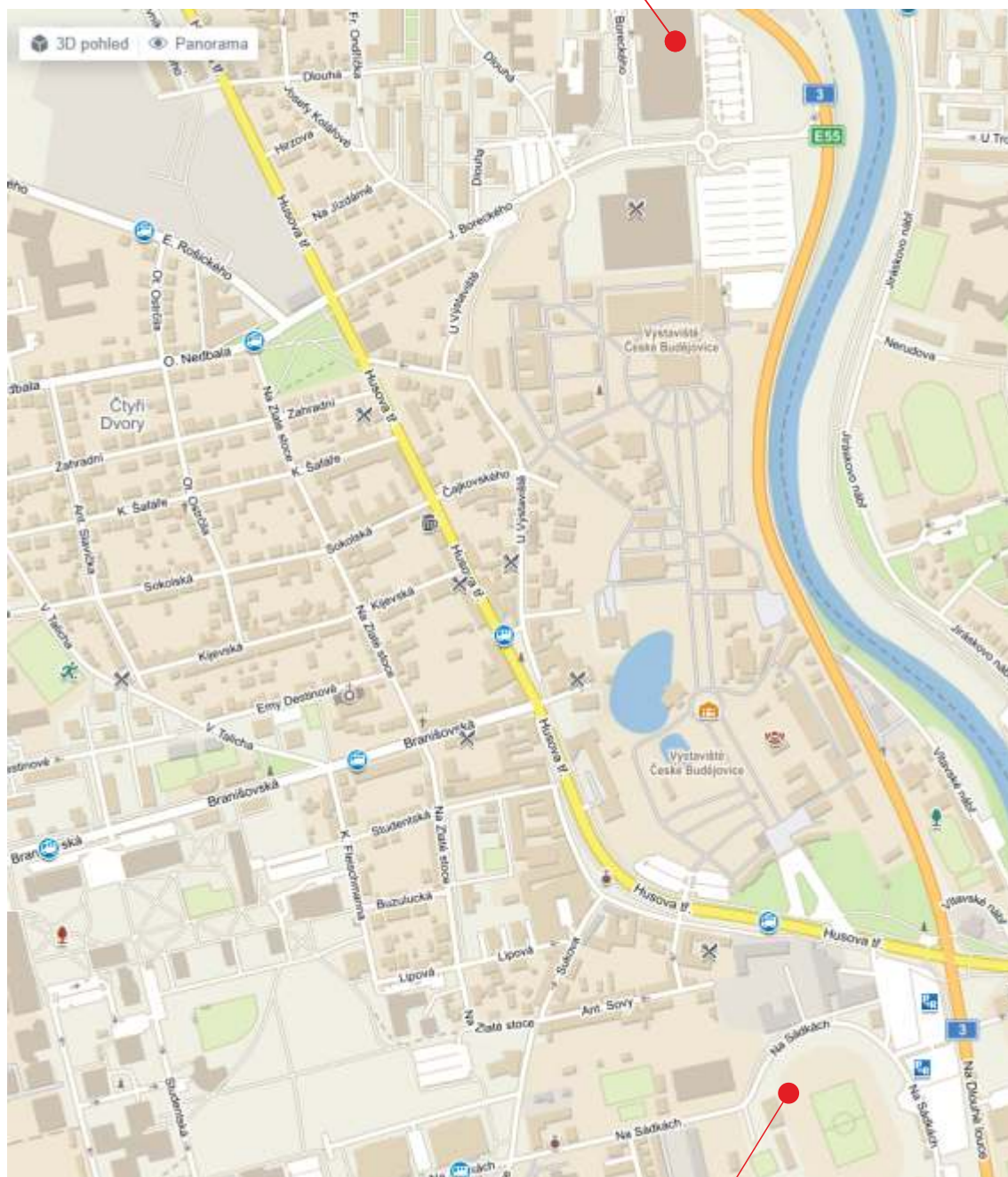
