### Why do we propose this change?

This proposal is connected to the proposal to change statute 1.21 regarding the official languages of the International Casting Sport Federation (ICSF).

ICSF has member countries from different parts of the world and must continue to strive for the expansion of casting sport. German is mostly spoken in central Europe and is therefore only beneficial as an official language for that part of the world. Therefore, the official language of the federation must be a language that is widely accepted as an international language. English is considered such a language and is the current global lingua franca.<sup>1</sup>

To make international communication easier, the Swedish Casting Federation therefore propose to change the official language to only English. Then it is only natural that proposals to the federation are written in English.
